Summary of key items and changes in the Adopted FY 2017- 2018 CCHD Budget:

REVENUE:

- ➤ A 0.29% decrease in total population to 97,552 will impact the amount of state and federal grant monies received.
- An increase in the per capita membership fee charged to the four towns from \$5.25 to \$5.75 (a 9.5% increase).
- ➤ Anticipated decrease in funding from the State Grant-in-aid to local health departments and the federal Asthma Prevention Grant.
- ➤ Anticipated increase in funding from the federal Preventative Health Block Grant.
- ➤ Anticipated revenues of approximately 2,600 influenza and pneumonia immunizations at \$95,000.

EXPENDITURES:

- ➤ Maintenance of employee health insurance costs through a high-deductible/health savings account plan.
- ➤ Cost for lease of office space in 5 municipal office locations in the 4 towns in the Health District is unchanged
