

Do you have a Medical Device or Equipment that requires Electricity?



Take the following four steps before a power outage:

1. Make arrangements with your equipment (such as oxygen tanks) vendor to have preset plans in case of loss of power.
2. Make a plan for potential power outages. Follow these links for two choices below:

3. Let Eversource, or your power company, know about your life-saving equipment needs.
 - a. Give your doctor or medical provider your Eversource account number.
 - b. Ask your doctor or medical provider to send a note to Eversource indicating that you have necessary medical equipment requiring electricity. Make sure that note includes your Eversource account number. Eversource will then provide the physician/medical provider with a form that the he or she will complete and return to Eversource.
 - c. Eversource is then able to contact you when there is a planned electrical outage.
4. Contact your Police Dispatch to let them know you have special medical needs. Berlin, and Wethersfield Police Departments have special needs registries. Rocky Hill PD has an Emergency Contact form with a spot for miscellaneous information. This information is on each Police Department website.
